

## Tuition Rate and Other Fees

1. To obtain the full-time tuition rate shown below, the student must be enrolled in at least 12 semester credit hours.
2. If a full-time student changes to part-time status by dropping to less than 12 semester credit hours, the part-time tuition rate applies to the remaining courses, and the student will be billed for the additional tuition charges.

### UNDERGRADUATE EDUCATIONAL COSTS

<b><i>Undergraduate Tuition &amp; Fees - Effective July 1, 2019 and continuing through June 30, 2020</i></b>	
Full-time Undergraduate Tuition Rate	\$500 per semester credit hour for onsite courses. *Courses taken online through Learning Solutions will be billed at same tuition rate plus applicable fees.
Part-time Undergraduate Tuition Rate	\$525 per semester credit hour
Application Fees: Undergraduate International and Meridian	\$50 (one time – due when application is submitted) \$100 (one time – due when application is submitted)
Enrollment Fee	\$150 (one time – due at initial registration)
Drop Fee	\$150 per course dropped (due at time the drop is made)
Change Fee	\$50 per course change (due at time the change is made)
Graduation Fee: undergraduate	\$250 one time - due March 31)
Credit by Demonstrated Competency Fee	\$75 per semester credit hour
CLEP Administrative Fee	\$25 per test
DSST Administrative Fee	\$25 per test
Transcript Fee	\$10 (student's account must be paid in full)
Recording Fee	\$50 per semester credit hour recorded from credit by standardized tests such as CLEP or DSST

Tuition Rate	\$200 per semester credit hour
Application Fees:	\$50 (one time – due when application is submitted)
Technology Fee: \$200	Each enrollment term
Administrative Fee: \$50	Each enrollment term
Payment Plan Fee	\$15 per month
Late Fee and Declined Payment Fee	A late fee of \$50 will be charged to student accounts that are past due or when auto payments are declined

The Accounting Certificate program is a one year, 27 credit-hour program. The student will complete two terms - a Fall term of 12 credit hours, and a Spring term of 15 credit hours. Materials are purchased separately.

Tuition Rate	\$575 per semester credit hour
Application Fees:	\$50 (one time – due when application is submitted)
Technology Fee: \$200	One Time Fee due at initial registration
Administrative Fee: \$100	One Time Fee due at initial registration
Late Fee and Declined Payment Fee	A late fee of \$50 will be charged to student accounts that are past due or when auto payments are declined

Students not enrolled as a degree seeking student will be billed per class. Tuition is due by first class date. Degree seeking students adding certificate classes to their program will be billed at the current certificate tuition rate. No discounts are given for certificate classes.
