ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP

Acquire the knowledge and skills to lead top-level teams within a for-profit or non-profit organization. Our 11-course curriculum includes local, national, and global perspectives, and focuses on topics including organizational processes, building strong and effective teams, organizing and leading groups, managing conflicts, and leading organizational change. There are no prerequisites for students with an undergraduate degree, and you'll earn this degree after completing 33 credit hours.


- Think and lead biblically, analytically, and managerially in addressing organizational situations.
- Explain various types and aspects of organizational culture and how they function as a whole.
- Build and implement a shared vision with a mission statement, organizational values, goals, and objectives.
- Explain how and why conflict occurs in an organization, and how a leader should view the opportunities and threats it presents.
- Articulate and synthesize unique aspects of leadership at national and international levels.
- Communicate the biblical and ethical foundations for each aspect of leadership.
- Explain and justify the necessity of a leader's spiritual life.



MASTER'S DEGREE THEOLOGICAL STUDIES

Develop the skills, techniques, and concepts for studying, practicing, and leading a theological discourse with our Theological Studies Master's degree program. You'll build a firm biblical foundation and connect theological truths with their impact on daily living. This degree is designed to help lay-people and ministry leaders develop sound theology, from an understanding of history to ethical decision-making. With courses on biblical and ethical leadership as well as elements of apologetics, and an intensive dive into Christian history, Systematic Theology, and practical application, you'll earn this degree after completing 42 credit hours.

- Articulate the fundamental aspects of Christian Theology.
- Identify future trends in order to keep scripture as the constant in an ever-changing culture.
- Think, research, synthesize, integrate, and apply theological principles and concepts to ethics and leadership.
- Explain the major differences and commonalities between the historical Christian theological system and other major theological systems.
- Develop a robust and coherent theological apologetic for your personal faith.



MASTER'S DEGREE BIBLICAL STUDIES

Learn and experience the tools, methods, and skills crucial to engage and teach the Bible in-depth and in context. Our Master's degree in Biblical Studies features core biblical theology, biblical languages, and the key skills for biblical exposition. By building your confidence and competence in rightly handling God's word and sharing that word with God's people, you will be prepared to accomplish your own goals, whether that's a more meaningful devotional life or teaching classes in your church.

- Demonstrate the core competencies of biblical exegesis and biblical exposition.
- Understand the basics of biblical languages and using a Bible software tool.
- Articulate a sound biblical theology grounded in the biblical worldview.
- Analyze and critique various methods and interpretations within the realm of Biblical Studies.
- Learn how to translate the Bible into the daily lives of God's people, helping them to live more faithfully and share more boldly.
- Acquire deep understanding of the relationship between biblical theology and systematic theology.



MASTER'S DEGREE CHRISTIAN MINISTRY

Gain the competencies you'll need to shepherd people from a biblical perspective. Practical and hands-on, with at least one interactive learning lab, our Master's degree in Christian Ministry will prepare you for leadership in your church and community. Choose from educational tracks that will strengthen your abilities in pastoral counseling, leadership, administration, and church planning. You'll also develop competencies in classical skills, including Bible exposition and theology.

Our Master's degree in Intercultural Leadership is a rigorous degree built on a multidisciplinary curriculum that draws on scholarship in missiology, theology, sociology, and anthropology. With an emphasis on intentional practices to foster academic, vocational, spiritual, emotional, and cultural formation, this degree is ideal for both seasoned and newer intercultural professionals.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP & INNOVATION

Set out on a path toward successful entrepreneurship—created by actual entrepreneurs. This one-year certificate program consists of eight different areas of focus, and is grounded in an in-depth understanding and application of how to be a person of Christ-focused moral character in pursuit of your dream or idea. In one year, you will learn the basics of entrepreneurship, a process to evaluate any concept or product, and how to innovate and lead a team with character-focused filters. Coursework can be completed one night per week on-site or via Zoom.

- Approach entrepreneurship in a character-focused, Spirit-led way.
- Understand the role of vision and innovation in bringing a product or idea to market.
- Successfully communicate through persuasion and storytelling.
- Apply character-focused leadership in creating a culture for your organization.
- Understand the importance of business law and corporate formation for your idea, product, or service.
